Unforgettable moments

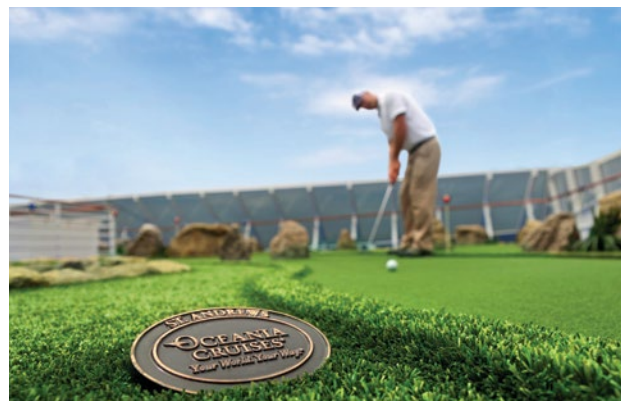
